2. Get of Sire shall consist of 4 animals, either sex, any age from the sire.
3. Produce of Dam shall consist of 2 animals, either sex, any age from the dam.
4. To be eligible for Champion Rosette exhibit must have won a blue ribbon in the class.

Dairy ages are computed as follows:

- Junior heifer calf born after January 1 of current year.
- Senior heifer calf born between July 1 of prior year and January 1 of current year.
- Junior yearling born between January 1 of prior year and July 1 of current year.
- Senior yearling born between July 1 two years prior and January 1 of current year.
